7. Location of Medical Room and Emergency Treatment Room

The Medical Room is located in the building behind the Eddie Diplock Stand and the Emergency Treatment Room is also located behind 'Eddie Diplock Stand' next to the Oaks Cafe . Padlock code is 1905

8. Location of emergency equipment (Duo Fold Stretcher, Defibrillator)

The stretcher and defibrillator are in the home changing room and another defibrillator is held in the Club House

Stretcher Team will work in assistance with the Lead First Aider

If a player is stretchered off, they will be transported directly to the Emergency Treatment Room or home changing room in order to be assessed by the Lead First Aider available at the time while waiting for the medical service to arrive.

9. Location of First Aid Bags

All Teams or club events onsite will have a personal First Aid Bag

A first aid bag can also be found in the Medical Room

Ice Packs will be offered and if needed, the Lead First Aider will provide on the day from their First aid bag

10. Pitchside Matchday Signals:

One Hand For ASSISTANCE

Crossed Hand For BLOOD INJURIES

Two Hands For STRETCHER

TRANSPORTATION TO HOSPITAL

11. Route from pitches to ambulance

Ambulance will arrive in to car park located near the turnstiles and drive down behind the Eddie Diplock Stand where this is a double metal gate (padlock code 19661) leading into Bourne stadium and straight to the pitch.

12. Route from the Emergency Treatment room to the ambulance

From the Treatment Room, turn left straight out the double gates, where the ambulance will be waiting (Emergency entrance to the pitch)

Find a local Service by Texting 61121

NHS Direct provides a handy text messaging service which will help you find the closest GP, dentist, pharmacy, optician, walk-in centre, A & E or hospital in England.

All you have to do is text the name of the service required, followed by the postcode, to 61121 and you will receive a text message in reply, with the service name, address and telephone number (where available), plus the distance from the postcode you supplied.

As an example, to find a local GP you would text the word GP and your full postcode to 61121 – e.g. GP SG4 9SY. If callers would like an extra three results, reply 'more' to the first message. The seven key words to access the seven local health services are: GP, Dentist, Pharmacy, Optician, Walk –in Centre, Casualty and Hospital.
